

# Frankfurt am Main

Frankfurt am Main is the largest city in the German state of Hessen. With its huge airport and the financial centre of Europe, it is the fifth largest in Germany.



The “**Zeil**” is known as a popular shopping street. It is in the middle of the city right at the train station “**Hauptwache**”. There is as well a weekly farmer’s market next to the Zeil, where you can buy fresh products and countless specialities from the surrounding region. It is called “**Kleinmarkthalle**”.



**MyZeil** is one of the biggest shopping centres in Germany. With its 42 meters long escalator, it is the longest in Europe. Shops on 8 levels provide an extraordinary shopping adventure for everyone.

The “**Alte Oper**” is a concert hall and opera house inaugurated in 1880. It is in the inner district of Frankfurt. Visitors can see famous musicals and shows like “Cats”.



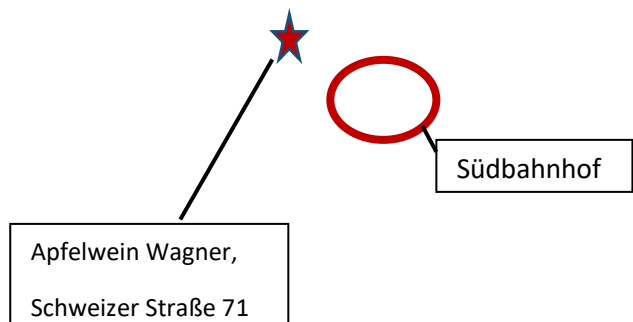
The **Frankfurt cathedral** of Saint Bartholomew is a Roman Catholic gothic church located in the centre of Frankfurt. It is the largest religious building in the city.

The “**Römer**” has been the city hall of Frankfurt for over 600 years. The square right in front is as well in the centre of Frankfurt.
