Your First Steps

Your s-number (e. g. s123456) and the corresponding password are your central login credentials – you use them to log in to almost all university systems and services, such as CampusPortal, Moodle, e-mail or WLAN.

1. Activate university account and change password

2. Multi-Factor-Authentication (MFA)

MFA provides additional protection for your account – in addition to your password, a second confirmation step (e. g. app code) is required when logging in.
