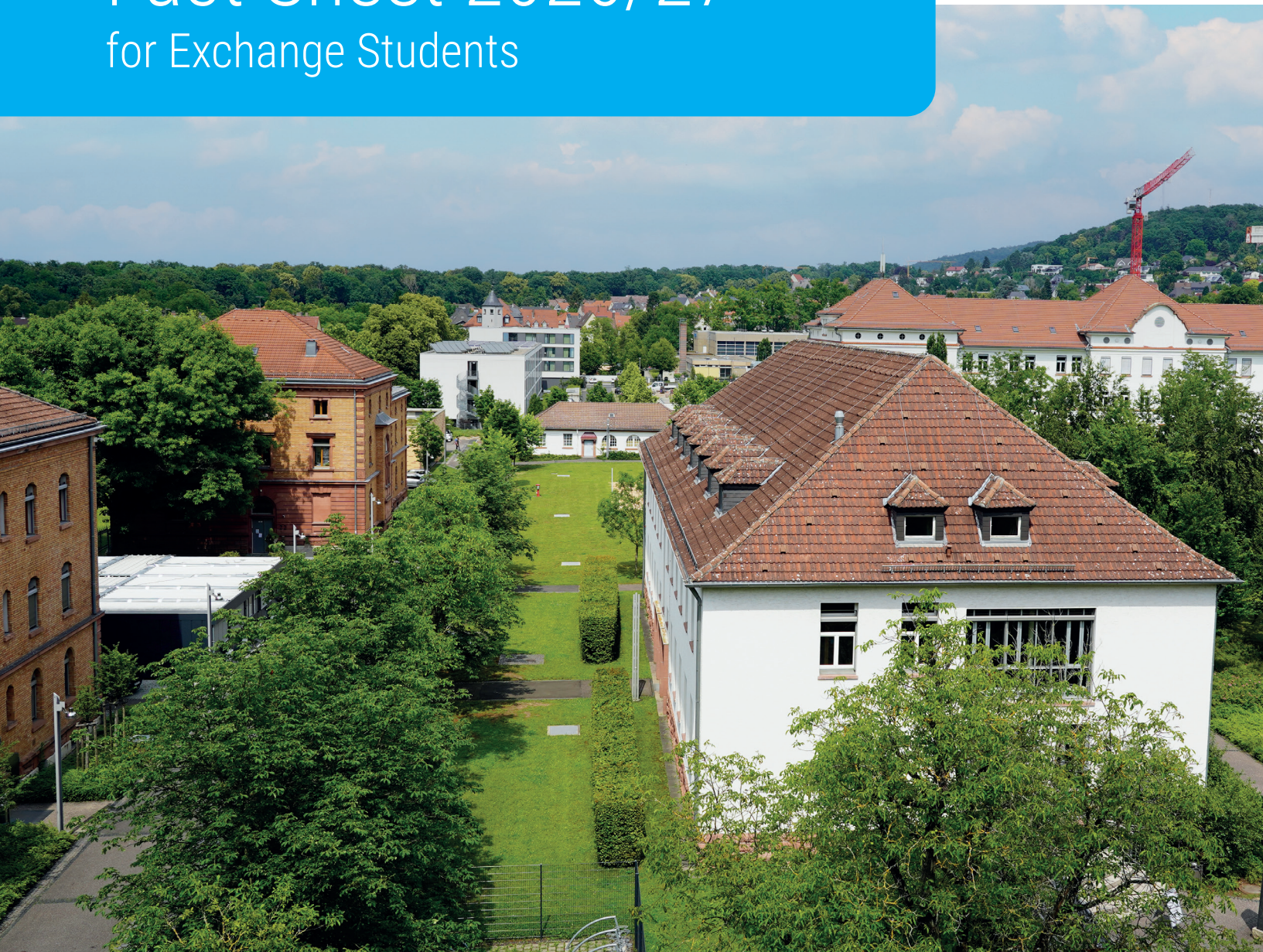

Each course awards a fixed number of ECTS credits. In Germany, 30 ECTS credits equals a standard workload. Although Aschaffenburg UAS does not have an ECTS requirement, we strongly recommend taking at least 10 ECTS credits per semester.

## Buddy Programme & Welcome Weeks

As an international student, you will be matched with a local “buddy” who will help you get settled in Aschaffenburg. Your buddy, who is a student at Aschaffenburg UAS, will help you with all your administrative and social queries on arrival in Aschaffenburg and during the Welcome Weeks.

## Health Insurance

All students studying in Germany must have health insurance that is accepted in Germany. If you are from an EU country, please check that your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) is valid. You can then [ask for an exemption from German health insurance](#).

If you come from a non-EU country, you can buy German statutory health insurance (about €135 per month) or [ask for an exemption if you have private insurance](#).

## Semester Fee

All students of Aschaffenburg UAS, including Erasmus+ and exchange students, have to pay a semester fee of 70 EUR. You will receive further information after your application.

## Arrival

[Frankfurt am Main \(FRA\)](#) airport is the closest major airport to Aschaffenburg (~ 50 km). From Terminal 1, it is easy to reach Aschaffenburg Hbf (main station) by train. From there, you can take a bus or train to get to the university (Hochschule, Aschaffenburg or Aschaffenburg Hochschule). We recommend using the [DB Navigator app](#) or the [Deutsche Bahn](#) website when planning and buying a ticket.

Be careful: some slower travel options may require a different ticket. Also note that there are two different train stations at Terminal 1. ICE trains are the fastest option. They leave from “Frankfurt Flughafen Fernbahnhof”.
