Notes on the application

- 1. The following documents must be submitted with the application:
 - Copy of the transcript of records/certificate or similar with stamp and signature of the educational institution
 - One portfolio for each (sub-)module applied for:
 - Cover sheet
 - Copy of the transcript of records/certificate or similar.
 - Content descriptions (extracts from module handbooks; if not available: Structure of the course, teaching and training plans of the institution)
 - Document showing how many hours the subject was taught at the educational institution
 - Document stating the type and duration of the examination
- 2. In accordance with Section 6 (2) sentence 2 APO, competences acquired outside the higher education sector may replace a maximum of half of the competences to be acquired in the degree programme. If this maximum limit is reached, it is not possible to credit theoretical or practical achievements beyond this.
- 3. The application for credit transfer must be submitted to the Student Services by the end of the lecture period of the semester in which enrolment or a change of degree programme took place. If you are applying for admission to a higher semester, the application must be submitted during the application period.
- 4. Be sure to list <u>all modules</u> to which your credit transfer application relates.
- 5. The more detailed and substantiated your application is, the faster it can be processed and the greater the chances of it being recognised.
- 6. The recognition of competences acquired outside the university always requires the recognition of study periods (i.e. you are treated as if you had already studied one or more semesters in the relevant degree programme). The allocation to a specific semester is determined on the basis of the scope of the recognised credits. Recognition does not entitle you to a course programme corresponding to the progress of your studies.

Additional information for applicants for a higher semester

- Be sure to apply early within the application deadlines so that the examination board has enough time to assess your performance.
- 8. At least the following number of ECTS credits must be recognised for admission to the higher semester:

2nd semester: 15 ECTS points 3rd semester: 45 ECTS points 4th semester: 75 ECTS points 5th semester: 105 ECTS points

If in doubt, you should also apply for the first semester of your chosen degree programme (only possible for the winter semester).

Please note that in degree programmes with restricted admission, admission to a higher semester is dependent on capacity utilisation.
