Notes on the application

- 1. The following documents must be submitted with the application:
 - > Notarised transcript of records with stamp and signature of the university
 - > For each (sub-)module applied for, a portfolio with*:
 - Cover sheet
 - Copy of the transcript of records
 - Excerpts from the module handbook (if not available: content descriptions, lecture outline)
 - If this information is not contained in the transcript of records or module handbook: document stating the scope of the subject applied for (ECTS points and weekly semester hours)
 - For the internship semester additionally: The internship certificate from the training organization and, if applicable, the internship report.
 - * No portfolios are required for achievements from a semester abroad that have been recognised in advance, provided that no changes have occurred.
- 2. The application for recognition must be submitted to the Student Services by the end of the lecture period of the semester in which enrolment or a change of degree programme took place. If you are applying for admission to a higher semester, the application must be submitted during the application period.
- 3. Be sure to list all the modules to which your application for recognition relates.
- 4. The more detailed your application is, the faster it can be processed and the greater the chances of it being recognised.
- 5. The recognition of study and examination achievements always requires the crediting of study periods (i.e. you are treated as if you had already studied one or more semesters in the relevant degree programme). The allocation to a specific semester is determined solely by the scope of the recognised examination and study achievements. Recognition does not entitle you to a course programme corresponding to the progress of your studies.

Additional information for applicants for a higher semester

- 6. Be sure to apply early within the application deadlines so that the examination board has enough time to assess your achievements at other universities.
- 7. At least the following number of ECTS credits must be recognised for admission to the higher semester:

2nd semester:	15 ECTS credits
3rd semester:	45 ECTS points
4th semester:	75 ECTS points
5th semester:	105 ECTS points

If in doubt, you should also apply for the first semester of the desired degree programme (only possible for the winter semester). Please note that admission to a higher semester in degree programmes with restricted admission is dependent on capacity utilisation.
